City of Clearlake Independence Day Festivities, *Clearlake, CA*

Maxine Sherman Memorial Fireworks Show, *Clearlake Oaks, CA*

Sunday, July 3, 2011

For a spectacular show, the best viewing area for the Maxine Sherman Memorial Fireworks display is on the water, anchored east of Rattlesnake Island, where the fireworks twinkle overhead and reflect off the waters of Clear Lake.
